

Using WordSpiel in the Classroom

Directions: Choose a word to use as your starting word. Provide 10 letters for the students to use to make words. Just like the game, the students must build a word that begins with the last letter(s) of the starting word. Give your students a set amount of time to come up with 20 words and choose which word they would play. Reasoning may include: this word uses the most cards, this word doesn't use all my vowels, this word ends with a tricky letter for the next player to work with, or this word uses a challenging letter, such as 'K' or "V."
